

# **Royal Incentive**

#### Day 1: Arrive Delhi by air

Welcome to India- a country where hospitality is a way of life to a culture steeped in tradition. You will be received at the airport with garlands and transfer to the hotel for overnight stay.

#### Day2: Delhi By coach

**Day 3:** Delhi To Jaipur by Flight or Coach. Morning proceed to the airport to board flight to Jaipur : Upon arrival at Jaipur, you will be greeted and welcomed in "Maharaja Style" a stunning tableau of decorated camels and elephants lead the procession and ladies in Rajasthani Costumes perform traditional "Tikka Ceremony" while the music of the Shahnai" welcomes you.

#### Day 4: Jaipur By coach

#### Day 5: Jaipur to Agra By coach

Morning drive down to Agra: (Agra was once the capital of the Mughal empire). En route pay a visit to Fatehpur Sikri the ghost capital built by the Mughal Emperor, Akbar. Overnight stay at the hotel.

### Day 6: Agra

Early morning guest will proceed to enjoy the magnificent sunrise view of the Taj Mahal (by decorated Rikshaws / Tonga -horse carts), built by Emperor Shah Jahan in the memory of his beloved wife Mumtaz Mahal. Also visit the Agra Fort -The fort is built alongside the Yamuna river.

**Day 7:** Agra to Delhi by Coach - Departure Morning drive back to Delhi en route photo stop at Sikandra - Built in the Indo-Saracenic style, Akbar's tomb at Sikandra. Arrive Delhi and in the evening enjoy your dinner with a theme Open Air Mughalai Bar-be-que - "Tandoor" is a clay oven which imbues the food cooked in it with a unique flavour. The host would present "Momento" as a token of love before escorting the group to the International Airport to board flight for onward destination.


### Day 2: Ranthambhore

#### WELCOME TO INDIA


#### Day 1: Arrive Delhi by air

### Day 2: Delhi

Morning start your tour with the Pooja ceremony at Laksmi Narayan Temple and White marble Bangla Sahib Gurudwara – the Sikh Shrine.Later drive to the walled city 'Old Delhi'. Passing by Chandni Chowk-Silver Square, Jama Masjid- India's largest mosque, Dariba Kalan (The Silver Bazaar) and The Red Fort. Afternoon visit to the Qutab Minar (The 72.5m high tower dates back to the 13th century). The other attractions are Rashtrapati Bhawan, the official residence of the President of India. and India Gate.

In the evening enjoy 'Bollywood theme'. Dancers will entertain you to movie songs, while enjoying the different Indian delicacies named on some of the popular Bollywood movies. The dinner place will be having the perfect ambience of the bollywood.



#### Day 3: Delhi to Agra by Express Train

### **Day 1:** Arrive Cochin by air


